ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

Accepted language tests and minimum scores:

- IELTS – (6.5) no band below 6.0
- TOEFL – (90) no band below 20
- CAEL – (70)
- CAE – (180)

English For Academic Purposes Program

Students who apply to StFX and do not meet the minimum English language requirements can join our English for Academic Purposes (EAP) program. With intermediate and advanced levels, the program prepares students for their studies at StFX.

stfx.ca/eap

Students in the advanced level may take a course from their academic program and earn credit toward their degree. Successful completion of the advanced level satisfies StFX's English language requirement.

APPLY TO STFX

Apply online for undergraduate programs. Graduate program information can be found at StFX.ca/academics/graduate-studies.

STEP 1 Apply online at stfx.ca/apply and pay the application fee of \$40 CAD. Apply before **March 1, 2022** to be eligible for scholarships.

STEP 2 Students must submit official transcripts upon graduation from high school. If you have attended a post-secondary institution, you must submit those transcripts with your application. Please email your transcripts and English proficiency test to admit@stfx.ca.

STEP 3 Apply for our scholarship program by completing your scholarship application profile by **March 15, 2022**.

STEP 4 Confirm your acceptance to StFX and guarantee a room in residence by **May 15, 2022**.

SCHOLARSHIPS

To be considered for a scholarship you must submit a completed application for admission to StFX by March 1. Applicants will be automatically assessed for national entrance scholarships. Applications for major scholarships must be completed by March 15. For more information and to see specific criteria for individual scholarships, visit StFX.ca/Scholarships.

STFX NATIONAL ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Entrance Scholarships are awarded based on a student's grade average from their last year of high school. Students with an average of at least 85% are typically considered for an award that range from \$5,000-\$12,000 awarded over four years.

STFX MAJOR SCHOLARSHIPS

Major scholarships typically include additional selection criteria and require an application. They range from one-time awards to renewable scholarships worth up to \$80,000 (awarded over four years.)

PROGRAM-SPECIFIC SCHOLARSHIPS

Students accepted into specific faculties or programs may be eligible for other scholarships and awards. The Gerald Schwartz School of Business and Brian Mulroney Institute of Government offer scholarships that international students qualify for.
