LOG IN TO YOUR STUDENT EMAIL ACCOUNT

Log in to mail.college.bm using the credentials you received after registration.

Username: firstname.lastname (i.e. jane.smith) Password: Date of Birth (Mmmddyyyy) (i.e Jan071989)

STEP CHANGE YOUR PASSWORD

After successful log in, you will need to change your password. Your new password must be 8 characters long (including 1 capital letter and 1 number. (i.e. Bermuda8)

STEP 3 DOWNLOAD AND LOG INTO THE BC APP

Now, with your new log in credentials, install and log into the BC app from the Apple or Google Play Store.

Locate the tab for Fall Orientation 2020 and register for the Virtual Orientation tour.
