MSVU's BBA Degree in association with Bermuda College



TARGET AUDIENCE

The accredited BBA degree programme is intended for past or current students enrolled in the Associate in Business Administration (ABUSA).

Graduates of a two-year associate degree or diploma programme from other accredited institutions may also be eligible to enroll in the BBA degree programme.

DURATION

Normally, if students attend full-time, the BBA degree can be complete in two years after the Bermuda College associate degree in business administration. Depending upon course availability, and if a student admitted to MSVU's BBA in association with Bermuda College receives the full 12.5 units of transfer credits, it is possible to complete the remaining 7.5 units in one and one-half years. For part-time students, MSVU offers courses in four semesters (September, January, May, and July) so it is possible to still finish the degree in two years.

COURSE START DATES

Courses normally begin in September, January, May, and July. Courses run for 13 weeks (less in summer terms). Students must register for courses by the deadline specified by MSVU.
