• Student Applicants:

In 2014/2015 the College received 459 applications. This count comprised 367 traditional and 92 non-traditional students.

• Student Enrolment:

In Fall 2014, the College enrolled 1,108 students.

II. PURPOSE

This Agreement outlines the transferability of courses from Bermuda College to the Bachelor of Science in Nursing and Bachelor of Science in Nursing Accelerate into Master's program at Walden University. Specific program-to-program articulations are set forth in Section III below.

III. ARTICULATION SPECIFICS

This articulation applies to Bermuda College students who completed their degrees in <u>2010 or later</u> as the program became regionally accredited by the NEASC at that time. Students from Bermuda College wishing to transfer in credits prior to 2010 must engage in a course-by-course evaluation with Walden's Global Transcript Evaluation (GTE) department.

Bermuda College students who successfully complete courses listed in the tables below with a grade of 'C' or better and meet the requirements for admission to the respective Walden Bachelor degree program may receive credit. All credits will be converted to the equivalent value for Walden credit.

Transfer of credit is subject to change based on curriculum updates by academic leadership.

IV. TERM AND TERMINATION

This Agreement will expire on the last day of the month, two years from the date that it is executed. Should any changes to the Agreement be required, it will be necessary to follow the process outlined in V(F). Either party may terminate this Agreement for any reason with 90 days written notice. Such termination shall not affect the rights of any students participating in any program under this Agreement prior to receipt of such notice. This Agreement will terminate automatically in the event that either party fails to maintain its accreditation status.

V. OTHER PROVISIONS

A. <u>Admission to Walden University</u>. Participation in this Agreement does not guarantee any Bermuda College student admission to Walden University. Potential students must apply in accordance with the procedures set forth by the University from time to time.

B. <u>FERPA</u>. For purposes of this Agreement, pursuant to the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 (FERPA), Walden and Bermuda College will only be permitted to exchange student information with an appropriate release provided by the student. A sample of such release is attached hereto as Attachment A.
