Note the \$50 application fee is waived by the completion of the articulation agreement outlined above. Students planning on majoring in Accounting would be required to take two additional courses prior to transfer in order to come in as a junior. Some options are a Natural Science, statistics II or a foreign language course.

This agreement applies to the following programs: accounting, entrepreneurship, finance, global supply chain management, human resource management, information systems, leadership and innovation, marketing and team and project management. \*VC validation exam required
